



PRIVACY POLICY

The company GOSTOS AFORTUNADOS - RESTAURAÇÃO UNIPESSOAL, LDA. (hereinafter referred to as "Black Whale Restaurant"), wants to establish solid and lasting relationships with its customers, based on transparency and trust. This Privacy Policy describes who we are, for what purposes we use the data of the holders, how we treat and store them, with whom we share them, for how long we keep them, as well as the ways to contact us and exercise your rights.

Who we are?

Your personal data will be processed by Black Whale Restaurant, legal person n.º 517 556 073 with headquarters at Rua Teófilo Braga, n.º 15, in Vila Franca do Campo, telephone number 296 123 456. Black Whale Restaurant is responsible for processing the personal data that it collects, processes and stores, in the sense in which such expressions are defined by the General Regulation on Data Protection (or "GDPR").

DEFINITIONS

To ensure a better understanding of this Privacy Policy it is important to know the concepts. For that reason, Black Whale Restaurant provides a glossary of the terms it considers most important:

Personal data

Any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"); An identifiable person is considered to be identifiable, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier, such as a name, an identification number, location data, electronic identifiers or one or more specific elements of the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

Treatment

Any operation or set of operations carried out on personal data or on sets of personal data, by automated or non-automated means, such as collection, registration, organization, structuring, conservation, adaptation or alteration, recovery, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or any other form of availability, comparison or interconnection, limitation, erasure or destruction.

Special categories of personal data

Personal data revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, as well as genetic data, biometric data that uniquely identify a person, data relating to health or data relating to sex life or sexual orientation of a person.

Sensitive categories of personal data

Personal data relating to the holder's economic or financial situation, (other) personal data that may lead to the stigmatization or exclusion of the data subject, usernames, passwords and other registration elements, personal data that may be used for fraud concerning identity.

Responsible for the treatment

Natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, individually or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of processing personal data.

Breach of personal data

Violation of security that causes, accidentally or unlawfully, the destruction, loss, alteration, disclosure or unauthorized access to personal data transmitted, stored or subject to any other type of treatment.

Privacy by default

It means ensuring that mechanisms are put in place within an organization to ensure that, by default, only the necessary amount of personal data will be collected, used and kept for each task. This obligation applies to the extent of its treatment, the period of conservation and its accessibility. These measures ensure that personal data are not made available without human intervention to an undetermined number of natural persons.

COOKIES

Cookies are used on the Black Whale Restaurant website to improve your browsing experience and provide the best possible service. Cookies are small files that are stored in access equipment through the browser, retaining only information related to preferences, thus not including personal data. Despite being able to manage cookies directly in the browser, by continuing to browse the site, the user will be consenting to their use; however, by disabling cookies, you may prevent some web services from working properly, partially or totally affecting navigation on our website.

HOLDERS' RIGHTS

Under the terms of the GDPR, data subjects have, among others, the following rights:

- Right of access;
- Right of rectification;
- Right to be forgotten;
- Right to limitation of processing;
- Right to data portability;
- Right of opposition;
- Right to withdraw consent.

TECHNICAL, ORGANIZATIONAL AND SAFETY MEASURES

Black Whale Restaurant implements and ensures the maintenance of adequate means of protection, so that its internal procedures for the security of personal data are in compliance with the regulations in force. Black Whale Restaurant also makes every effort to ensure that, contractually, the third parties with whom it collaborates, as partners or service providers, guarantee adequate protection of the personal data to which they have access. Black Whale Restaurant limits access to personal data to specific employees, and only when their contact with such personal data is justified, within the scope of their functions. Black Whale Restaurant takes the necessary measures to ensure the safe handling of personal data. In particular, it takes precautionary measures to protect personal data against loss or abuse, and uses security procedures to prevent unauthorized access to such personal data.
